NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Rancho Mirage will hold a public hearing at its regular meeting on June 15, 2023, beginning at 1:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, in the City Council Chamber, 69-825 Highway 111, Rancho Mirage, California, to hear public testimony of all interested parties for the purpose of:

CONSIDERING A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM RATES FOR THE COLLECTION, TRANSPORTATION AND DISPOSAL OF MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE AND THE COLLECTION AND RECYCLING OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS, YARD TRIMMINGS, FOOD SCRAPS AND CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held before the City Council ("City Council") of the City of Rancho Mirage ("City") on June 15, 2023, at 1:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, at Rancho Mirage City Hall, 69-825 Highway 111, Rancho Mirage, California. At the public hearing, the City Council will consider the adoption of a resolution establishing the maximum rates and charges for solid waste collection and removal that reflect the terms of the City's franchise agreement with the solid waste hauler, Burrtec Waste and Recycling Services ("Burrtec"), which is effective from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2032.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Government Code Section 53756, solid waste and recycling collection service charges have increased as noted in the enclosed Exhibit A to reflect pass-through and inflationary adjustments as based on the agreed methodology contained within the City's franchise agreement, which is available on the city website: <https://ranchomirageca.gov/residents/city-services/trash-and-recycling-services/>. Such increased charges shall be effective July 1, 2023 and shall be effective for five years with the noted annual adjustments indicated below.

The maximum rates shown on Exhibit A are subject to be adjusted annually by utilizing the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for All Urban Consumers, Los Angeles - Riverside - Orange County, CA, issued by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, and the methodology defined in Exhibit H: Annual Adjustments of Rates, Including Collection, Disposal Charges and City Fees, of the City's contract with Burrtec.

You have received this Notice because our records indicate that you receive Solid Waste Hauling services in the City and would therefore be subject to the proposed rates. Any interested person may attend the meeting and be heard or present written comments or protests of the proposed rates to the City Clerk at or prior to the conclusion of the public hearing. Mail written protests to the City Clerk, 69-825 Highway 111, Rancho Mirage, CA 92270. Written protests must be signed by a customer or property owner and must include the assessor's parcel number or street address of the property for which the protest is submitted. A written comment or protest may be submitted up to the conclusion of the public testimony at the public hearing. If, by the close of the public hearing, written protests of the proposed solid waste and recycling services rates are not presented by a majority of owners of the identified parcels upon which the proposed rates are to be imposed, the City Council will be authorized to impose the proposed solid waste and recycling services rates.

This will be a Public Hearing before the City Council to allow public testimony on the proposed solid waste and recycling services rate charges. The City Council will consider all written protests of the proposed charges, determine if a majority protest exists, and act on the necessary resolutions to adopt the solid waste and recycling services rates.

Restaurant Food Scrap Carts are serviced using the Divertible Materials rates for 35-gal, 65-gal, and 2-yard bins included above.

Temporary Bins for Recyclable Materials are intended for use at special events.

Weekly service for temporary MSW Bins or Small Generator Carts shall be charged the fee per lift multiplied by the number of lifts scheduled per week multiplied by the number of Bins on services multiplied by 4.33 weeks per month. (For example: one temporary Bin serviced two times per week is 124.27 x 2 x 1 x 4.33 = \$1,076.18 per month.)

City must approve customer use of Small Generator Carts prior to start of service. Small Generator Carts are intended for either (1) Businesses that generate less than 32-gallons of MSW and 32-gallons of Recyclable Materials per week or (2) Small restaurants participating in the Food Scrap Program. Restaurant Food Scrap Carts must always be packaged with MSW and Recyclable Materials Carts to prevent contamination in the Food Scrap Carts.

Small Compactors (4-6 cubic yard) will be charged at 3 times the regular Bin rate.

Split bins containing half MSW and half Recyclable Materials will be charged as follows. For 3 cubic yard, 4 cubic yard, and 6 cubic yard Split Bins, combine the MSW and Divertible Materials rates for the two sides using the rates above. Example: One three cubic yard split bin emptied once per week is the 1.5 cubic yard MSW rate of \$94.71 + the 1.5 cubic yard Divertible Materials rate of \$63.25 = \$157.96 per month for the 3 cubic yard split Bin emptied once per week. For a 4-yard split bin, combine the 2-yard MSW and 2-yard Divertible Materials rates based on collection frequency. For a 6-yard split bin, combine the 3-yard MSW and 3-yard Divertible Materials rates based on collection frequency.
